## **Code of Conduct for Parents/Carers**

In order to participate in Sussex Junior Chess events, parents are expected to:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat each equally.
- 2. Ensure that the children are aware of and adhere to the expectations of them in terms of behaviour (See Code of Conduct for Players)
- 3. Not attempt to exert undue influence on the result of a game or on any other decision affecting play (e.g. board order in team events)
- 4. Abide by, and teach children to abide by, the decisions of the arbiters and tournament organisers.
- 5. Raise any concerns about any aspect of a tournament promptly and constructively with the tournament organiser and abide by the subsequent decision of the organiser.
- 6. Consistently display high standards of behaviour
- 7. Not use or tolerate inappropriate language.
- 8. Respond promptly to any concern about the welfare of a child by reporting it to the organisers of the event.
